## **REPORT**

## Year in Infrastructure Conference

Each year Bentley holds their annual Year in Infrastructure (YII) Conference in the Fall. This year the YII Conference is taking place in **Singapore** on **October 10-12, 2017.** Each year at the YII Conference the Be Inspired Awards are presented. These awards recognize the best in the industry in many different categories.

Each year Archway supports nominees and have had those nominees go on to be finalists and winners at the YII Conference.

In 2016, BuildLACCD was a finalist in the Innovation in Government category for their project modernizing and renovating the Los Angeles Community College District's (LACCD) nine campuses and creating 67 new buildings using green technology. They used ProjectWise to store and coordinate all of their project data including the BIM specifications. BuildLACCD was named the winner in their category over Dholera's Dehli Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation project and the Research and Design Institute for Urban Transportation in Moscow.

engineering work for the Tehachapi
bypass, pictured above. J.L. Patterson
also won in 2013 in the Innovation in
Point Cloud Processing and
Management category. This project was
to design optimum corrective action for
a BNSF railroad tunnel in the Cascades.
They created a 2.5 terabyte point cloud
of the sides of the 8.1 mile long tunnel.
The problem was that double high
railroad cars were scraping the walls of
the tunnel which had previously been

In 2014, J.L. Patterson won the



notched at the top. J.L. Patterson did a regression analysis to determine the track alignment to the centerline of the notch, rather than the center of the walls which had previously been done. The adjusted alignment saved BNSF nearly \$9 million by reducing the excavation necessary.

Also in **2013**, **Dr. Francelina Neto**, a friend of Archway and educator at Cal Poly Pomona, won the **Educator of the Year Award**.

This conference is a great opportunity to see the many projects around the world using Bentley software to be more innovative, more efficient, and more effective. This year, Archway supported two projects from Jackie Patterson, formerly of J.L. Patterson, now Vice President of Jacobs, and John Cruikshank and Mary Wall of JMC2 Civil Engineering + Surveying.

The JMC2 project was submitted in the **BIM Advancements in Construction** category and features their project on creating a structure and net system to catch a skydiver who dived without a parachute. Bentley software was used for the entire project and the skydiver's jump was a huge success.

The Jacobs project was submitted in the BIM Advancements for Rail and Transit for their work on the California High Speed Rail Corridor from Burbank to Los Angeles to Anaheim. This project is still in the planning phases but by using Bentley's PowerRail Track and also UAVs to collect data, Jacobs were able to propose a solution to reduce time by over half and cost by over 85% and increase the image quality for the data collected. All of the data and designs are being stored and distributed through ProjectWise for all of the offices working on the project.

The finalists for the 2017 Be Inspired Awards will be announced in August and we are looking forward to seeing if Jacobs or JMC2 will be finalists so we can see their presentations in Singapore! Join us in Singapore in October to see all of the finalists presentations and the awards for all 17 categories. See more information on Bentlev's website.
