
Bentley's New Feature—Share

To use Share, you have to access it through your Projects. Once you've selected a project, you can click on the Share tile and Share files and folders with other team members for seamless efficiency among your whole team.

OpenRoads based on the latest in technology built on 25 years of leadership by InRoads, GeoPAK, and MX, is the most complete civil engineering road and site design software in the world. It consists of three parts: OpenRoads
ConceptStation, OpenRoads
Designer and OpenRoads
Navigator.

OpenRoads ConceptStation creates a model of a new corridor in just hours. What used to take days, now just takes hours. All projects start with a terrain model. You can have OpenRoads ConceptStation search the internet to find and use an existing DTM or create a new DTM with ContextCapture. Then you can sketch a horizontal alignment in plan and see the vertical profile to make quick adjustments. Click on the AASHTO standard for multilane highway or country road, step back and watch the 3D model created. Now you can add bridges, barriers, striping, offramps, intersections, etc. and then calculate quantities and costs.

If you need to present your model, just move it into **LumenRT** and you can add lighting, animations, etc. for a model to present to planning



commission, board, or others for approval. When the project is approved, move the model into OpenRoads Designer so you don't have to start from scratch.

OpenRoads Designer is a comprehensive multi-discipline solution for the advancement of roadway projects from conceptual design through construction. It includes and supports all aspects of a detailed roadway design including geotechnical, drainage, subsurface utilities, terrain, road, roadway furniture, and more. It blends together traditional engineering workflows for plan, profile and cross-sections with 3D parametric modeling to enable the

model-centric creation of all design deliverables. It supersedes all capabilities previously delivered through InRoads, GEOPAK, MX and PowerCivil.

OpenRoads Navigator helps you work better, smarter, and faster to help resolve issues and speed up approvals. You can use OpenRoads Navigator to work between your office, site and field in order to take all of your data with you and resolve issues faster. In the office or in the field, review, navigate and mark-up 3D models. Perform virtual walkthroughs on site and explore the models and their property data.
